## **Teaching Essay Writing through Process Writing Approach**

Essay writing is a crucial skill for students of all levels. It is a fact that the students in a Pakistani ESL context find it really difficult and look for readymade material to get grades in exams. Moreover, it becomes a hazardous task for teachers to teach essay-writing; keeping in mind students' previous knowledge and demotivation in writing classes. As a result, Pakistani ESL students fail to fulfill the demands of experts who look for "cohesive, logical, structured, interesting and organized" (Jacob& L, 1981; Hall, 1988) essays.

Process writing approach empowers students to write effective essays following the easy steps. This Academic session will engage participants in hands on activities through which participants will be able to use and apply the following four stages of process writing approach (Badger & White, 2000) in their essay writing teaching sessions.

- Pre-writing
- Drafting
- Revising
- Editing
