

# Teaching Vocabulary: beyond words.

A lot of recent vocabulary research in English Language Teaching has emphasised the need to go beyond words and to teach common combinations of words such as collocations and lexical phrases, which are so important to both spoken and written fluency. In this workshop, I will suggest how we can redesign common activity types to focus on such combinations, with the ultimate aim of enabling learners to notice units beyond the word autonomously.



**Ivor Timmis** is Emeritus Professor of English Language Teaching at Leeds Beckett University. He has worked as a teacher, teacher educator, materials writer, and researcher. His main classroom

interests are in speaking skills and teaching vocabulary. This work has taken him to around 30 countries to speak at conferences and to lead teacher development workshops. He is the co-author (with Freda Mishan) of *Materials Development for TESOL*.
