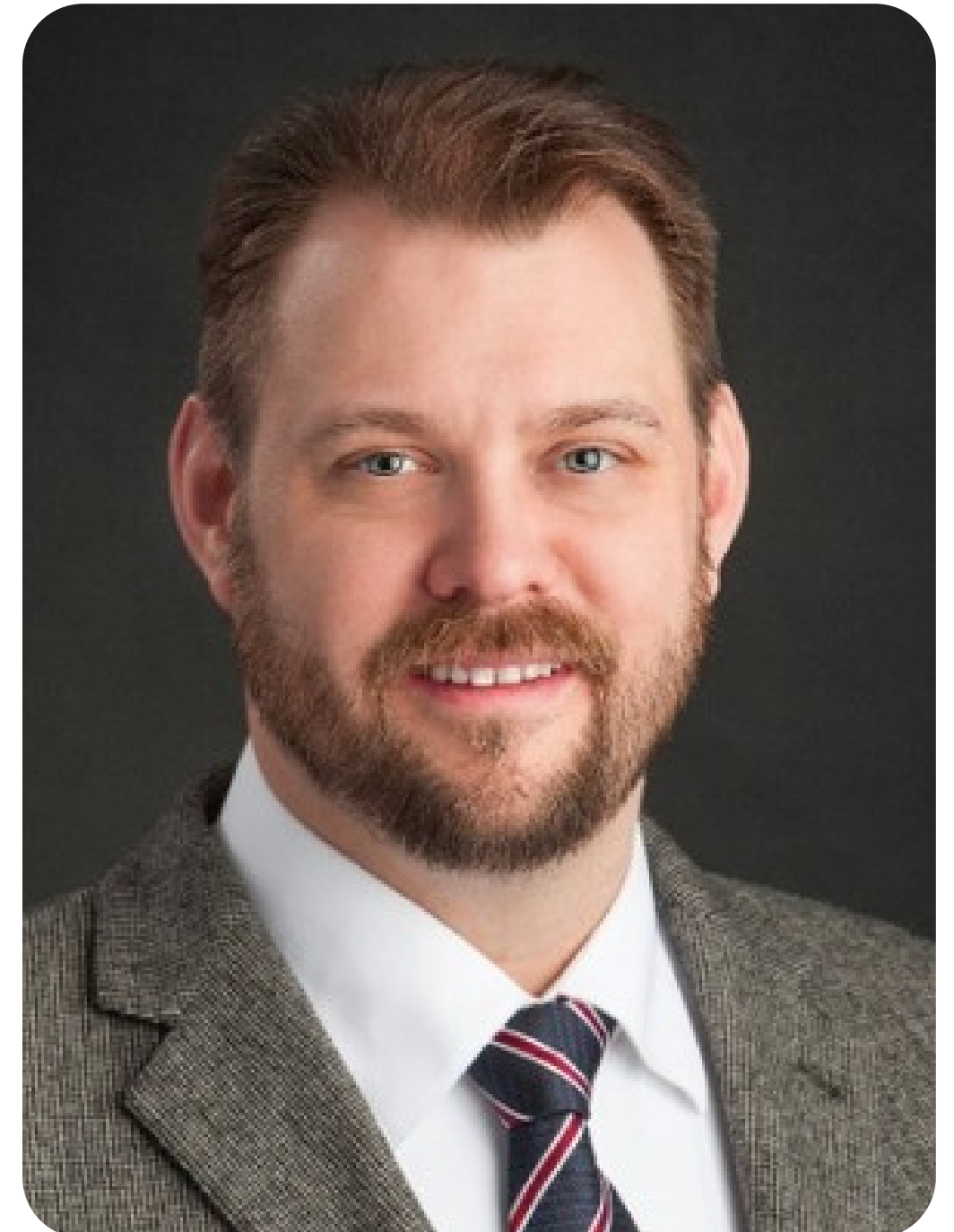


The Stories We Tell About Teaching
