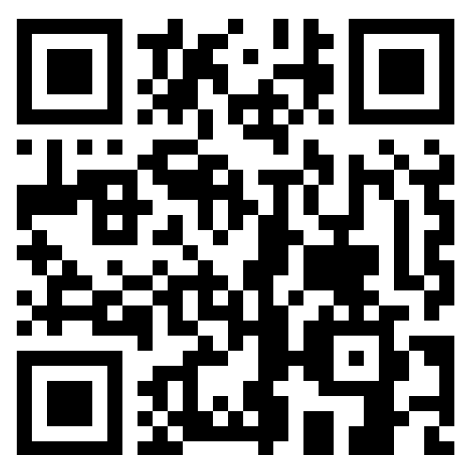

Beyond the Bot: Teach Smart, Think Smarter

As digital tools become more accessible in Pakistani classrooms, teachers and educators are increasingly experimenting with AI for lesson planning, vocabulary practice, feedback, and assessment support. Yet technology alone does not guarantee meaningful learning. This workshop invites educators to move beyond passive reliance on automated tools and instead cultivate critical thinking, ethical awareness, and learner autonomy. Grounded in a humanistic perspective, the discussion emphasises the teacher's role as mentor, cultural guide, and empathetic facilitator, something an AI bot can't replace. Ultimately, the goal is not to replace teachers with technology, but to empower them to teach smartly, responsibly, and with deeper pedagogical purpose.
