

From Pages to Practice: Making Books that Amplify Language Acquisition

In this fast-paced on-line workshop, participants will learn how to make books with their students that lend themselves to key language uses such as narrate, inform, explain and argue. Book structures, using one sheet of paper include: zine (Inform/ Narrate), concertina (Explain/ Inform), pull and peek zine (Explain/ Narrate), Turkish map fold (Explain/ Inform/ Narrate) and theater book (Argue/ Narrate). The materials needed include A4 paper, cardstock, cash register paper, flash cards, glue sticks, and scissors. Participants will also brainstorm and share how to apply what we are learning to their specific contexts.
