As language teachers, sometimes we get so involved in teaching the mechanics of writing that we tend to neglect all the fun and creativity related to the process of writing. Also, we are constantly looking for ideas to help our kids get started on writing assignments, improve their craft of writing, develop stories, and just keep writing.

One tried-and-tested method of generating a lot of writing in the classroom is through prompts; stimuli a teacher uses to get learners to give a response using the target language. In this hands-on creative writing workshop, we will work through some of the prompts (visual, spoken, and written) that the facilitator has used in his classrooms with a diverse range of age and ability groups. All the prompts and tasks that we play with in this workshop have worked for the facilitator, and have provided the desired result of helping learners become better writers.

- Learn about the foundations of strong writing
- engage in activities and strategies related to teaching of creative writing
- overcome their own fear of writing
- identify the process of sharing students' writing in their classrooms.
