Active learning aims to engage students in the learning process. It is defined as 'anything that involves students in doing things and thinking about the things they are doing'. It takes on the development and enhancement of the three learning domains: knowledge, skills and attitudes (KSA) by offering equal opportunity to students in a class to develop connections with the prior knowledge; think critically; get involved in the course content; apply concepts; compose own material and reflect on the learning experiences.

Active learning refers to a wide choice of teaching strategies that involve variety of modes of interaction and pedagogical frameworks. Ranging from individual to group work, the educators can opt for short, simple activities to extended, structured tasks. Most importantly, using active learning strategies does not even require abandoning the lecture format; adding small active learning strategies can suffice the need and ensure attainment of teaching and learning outcomes.

During this workshop teachers will:

- Explore the impact and implementation of active learning to excite, engage and empower students in their learning process.
- Be engaged in hands-on teaching strategies to promote active learning.
- Showcase own best teaching practices for enrichment of KSA.
