

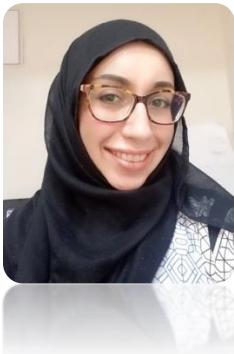
Teaching English Pronunciation Effectively

- Teaching Pronunciation Activities




