SPELT In Coordination with York University & Lancaster University, UK Raising Teacher Awareness of Dyslexia and Inclusive Practices

Dyslexic learners belong to a group of individuals with Special Educational Needs (SEN). Language learners and multilinguals with Special Learning Difficulties (SpLDs) need to be introduced to inclusive teaching practices and provided with individualized support. Language teacher education schemes hardly offer initial training and continuous professional development opportunities in this respect.

*This **Six-hour** workshop will be offered in collaboration with the universities of York and Lancaster, UK to raise language teachers' awareness of dyslexia and inclusive language teaching practices, which will give an opportunity to the participants to discuss the issues and indulge in hands-on materials development for the dyslexic students.*
