Global English Education China Assembly, 2023



Prof. Zakia Sarwar, a founder member and patron-in-chief of SPELT was invited as a featured represent to organisation at the 6th Global English China Assembly held in Macao from 28-30 July, 2023. Approximately 1600 Chinese teachers participated in this 3-day event to gain from the knowledge and expertise presenters from over 20 countries from around the world. These included experts from the USA, UK. New Zealand, Italy, Thailand, Russia, Singapore, Nepal, Mongolia, Indonesia, and Pakistan. The theme was "New Opportunities for the World with New Advances in China's Development: Opening up New Prospects in English Education Cooperation Worldwide". year's assembly was hosted by China Daily, Shanghai International Studies University and organized by City University, Macao and China Daily's **21**st Century **English** Education Media.

The formal inaugural session began in a packed auditorium with a beautiful and soothing music performance which settled the audience. This was followed by inaugural speeches of the honoured chief guest and other invitees. These were mainly delivered in Chinese, but the rest of the conference proceedings were in English. In the course of 3 days, there were nine keynote speakers who shared their thoughts on a variety of topics. June Liu spoke about the Future Role of English, David Nunan about Paradigm Shift in Language Education, and Mao Sihui on Cultivating Active Glocal Citizenship for China TESOL: Challenges and Strategies. He outlined the importance of acquainting the world with Chinese customs and cultural values. The online Closing Keynote was from Stephen Krashen discussing "'Study' versus Pleasure Reading" which enables language learners to learn English in a non threatening way. Over a hundred presentations were also made, in parallel sessions, by Chinese teachers from schools, colleges, and universities. Prof Zakia Sarwar representing SPELT as a featured speaker, presented her research on "Empowering EFL Learners to Become Proficient Users of English", which was well received.

The China Assembly placed a great deal of importance on acquainting the world about Chinese values and culture and the Chinese teachers to become familiar with cultures of other countries. This follows Xi Jinping's idea of 'building a community with a shared future for mankind'. Just as the Silk Route in our part of the world connected the neighbouring regions, 'Belt and Road Initiative' dreams of using the English language as a bridge, and thus the world can be connected for a shared and peaceful future.
